From SAA to Restaurants + Shopping:

Meijer:

Turn right on Hempstead and Right into Meijer Parking lot. The restaurants are around the perimeter of the lot.

Wilmington Pike N. Restaurants:

Turn Left on Hempstead, Left on E. David Road and Left on Wilmington Pike.

Wilmington Pike S. Restaurants:

Turn Left on Hempstead, Left on E. David Road, and Right on Wilmington Pike.

Town & Country Shopping Center:

Turn Left on Hempstead, Right on E. David, and Right on SR 48.

Or...

Turn Right on Hempstead, Left on Stroop.

Cross Pointe Shopping Center:

Turn Left on Hempstead, Right on E. David Road, Left on SR 48, and Left onto Alex-Bell.

Or...

Turn Left on Hempstead, Right on E. David, Left on Marshall, Right on Whipp, Left on SR 48, and Left on Alex-Bell.

Other Close Shopping and Restaurant Areas:

Dayton Mall:

Turn Left on Hempstead Station, Left on E. David, Right on Wilmington Pike. Take I-675 South to Exit #2 (Rt. 725).

Mall at Fairfield Commons:

Turn Left on Hempstead Station, Left on E. David, Right on Wilmington Pike. Take I-675 North to Exit #17 (N. Fairfield Road).
